- 6. What revolutionary things did Madame Pommery do to accomplish her vision of champagne? How long did it take her to succeed?
- 7. What were the obstacles impeding Madame Pommery's success in her winery?
- 8. Who were Madame Pommery's adversaries, and how did she overcome them? Who was the worst adversary?
- 9. Who had surprising talents that end up helping Madame Pommery? Who was the most unlikely person that helped her?
- 10. What lessons does Madame Pommery learn about the class system of Nobles, Bourgeoisie and Poor? What did she want for her daughter?
- 11. What would life with the Baron offer her? What choice does she make for herself and why?

- 12. What was the Franco-Prussian war all about? How did it cause a civil war between Communards and the French government in Paris?
- 13. What was Prussia's goal in baiting Napoleon III to declare war on them? Did they want to take over France, or was there something more secretive? Did they accomplish their goal?
- 14. Madame Pommery had many interests and passions. What legacy did she leave behind?
